## CHILDREN

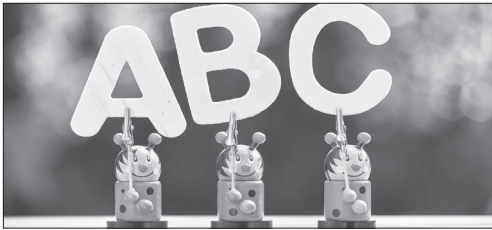
Children 8 and younger should be accompanied by an adult or caregiver age 12 or older.

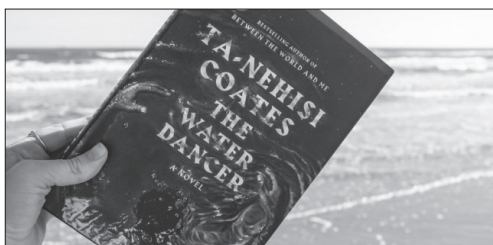

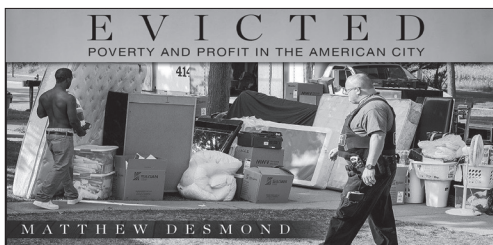

Educator and historian John Ulferts will share about the history of WWII. **OL**

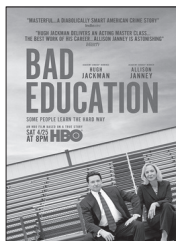
