The Judy Adams BookQuest Competition is Beloit Public Library's annual Battle of the Books-style competition held for area 4th and 5th graders.

Students from area public and private schools are encouraged to participate. We also encourage homeschool groups to put together teams.

Each team consists of four or five students, and each school sends one to three teams to the competition. Teams compete against one another for bragging rights ... and trophies!

A new list of 25 books is released each spring, and students spend all year reading and preparing for the competition, which takes place the following spring. Teams make the most of BookQuest by coming up with fun team names and meeting up throughout the year to discuss the books.
